



- 2- What day was it? (Sabbath—Rest day)
- 3— Why is a Sabbath Day important? (God commanded a day of rest to spend time with God)
- 4— Why were the Pharisees mad? (The disciples did work by picking grain & eating it—they were supposed to rest)
- 5— What else did Jesus do on Sabbath? (Healed a person's hand & brought a man back to life.)
- 5-What question did Jesus ask them? (Are we supposed to help people or harm them? Jesus was helping people.)
- 6-What can you do to help people like Jesus did?
